

Media accreditation for the FIFA Fan Fests in Russia

Since the 2006 FIFA World Cup™ in Germany, the FIFA Fan Fests gathered almost 30 million people to watch the matches live and enjoy an exciting entertainment programme free of charge. In Russia, once again those official public viewings of the FIFA World Cup matches will welcome fans from all over the world in iconic venues in all 11 Host Cities.

Media representatives willing to cover and report from the FIFA Fan Fest venues are required to obtain a specific “FIFA Fan Fest Media Accreditation Pass” through one of the following simplified processes.

1. If you are already accredited for the 2018 FIFA World Cup™

After collecting your FIFA World Cup accreditation at one of the event’s accreditation centres, please head to the FIFA Fan Fest Accreditation Office taking the event accreditation and your passport, sign the Terms & Conditions and collect your FIFA Fan Fest Media Accreditation Pass.

2. If you have a Team Site Pass to attend media activities at the Team Base Camps

After collecting your Team Site Pass please head to the FIFA Fan Fest Accreditation Office taking the Team Site Pass and your passport, sign the Terms & Conditions and collect your FIFA Fan Fest Media Accreditation Pass.

3. If you are not accredited for the 2018 FIFA World Cup™ and also do not have a Team Site Pass

Journalists not accredited for the event that would like to cover and report from the FIFA Fan Fest venues should apply [here](#) for a City Press Center badge to the Host City Press Centres. Once you have collected your City Press Center badge, please head to the FIFA Fan Fest Accreditation Office taking the City Press Center badge and your passport, sign the Terms & Conditions and collect your FIFA Fan Fest Media Accreditation Pass.

The Terms & Conditions signed and the FIFA Fan Fest Media Accreditation Pass will be valid for the FIFA Fan Fest venues across all 11 Host Cities, meaning you will have to go through the process described above only once. Please note that it is necessary to wear one of the three accreditations listed above and the FIFA Fan Fest Media Accreditation Pass while you are at the FIFA Fan Fest sites.

Camera and photographer platforms are available in all 11 FIFA Fan Fest venues, with FIFA Media Rights Licensees having privileged access to some positions. According to the Terms & Condition that shall be signed on-site, any filming of the big screens while match content is shown is strictly prohibited for broadcasters and other media than the appointed Media Rights Licensees for Russia.
